On November 13, 2006, Plaintiff GMG Capital Investments, LLC filed an Amended Complaint alleging that the court has jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 1332 (diversity jurisdiction). A limited liability company is a citizen of the states of which each its members are citizens. See Carden v. Arkoma Associates, 494 U.S. 185 (1990); Hale v. MasterSoft Int'l Pty. Ltd., 93 F.Supp.2d 1108 (D. Colo. 2000). Accordingly, the Plaintiff has not alleged complete diversity of citizenship between all of the Plaintiffs and all of the Defendants. See 28 U.S.C. § 1332. Plaintiff is hereby ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE within ten days of the date of this Order why the court should not dismiss the Amended Complaint for lack of subject matter jurisdiction.
