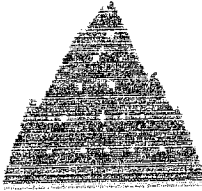

Your Honor,

We received your ruling, and are now convinced beyond any doubt you were "bought and paid for" by your Mormon associates who work for Novell. It is clear that you have elected to place your personal self-serving career interests over United States law and our rights, and have cut some type of deal with these people. This ruling is harsh, unfair, highly prejudicial, and contrary to the facts in this case.

I have attached a copy of the complaint filed against you with the Utah Judicial Commission. This complaint was filed in August against you. I now ask that you recuse yourself from this case, and save us the trouble of filing a rule 63B motion. You have been under investigation by the Judicial Commission for many months, and no doubt, your knowledge of this investigation biased this ruling.

We are sending the Judicial Commission investigation and documents to the press as a defense against this unfair and prejudicial ruling. We are also preparing an appeal, and a motion to set aside the ruling, and ask that you step aside, so that we can be assured of a fair and honest ruling in this matter, without your personal self-serving interests going ahead of our rights. The most unclean hands of all in this matter are your honors hands, who, after sponsoring a bogus replevin that mirrors almost exactly Joseph Smith's burning of a printing press in Illinois, then attempted to cover your own behind by attempting to railroad a non-Mormon run business into the ground in the hope that we would roll over and play dead for Novell. Keep dreaming, it isn't going to happen.

We will require that yourself and your clerk be called as witnesses at trial. We are entitled to know who you have been "deal cutting" with, this includes reviews of your phone records and other materials. We have unrefutable evidence of your activities with former clients at Ray Quinney, and the backroom deals you cut with Alan Sullivan to get your former clients to drop the charges so you could stay on this case, and engage in more "deal cutting" with your career politician friends in Salt Lake City. These materials are being transmitted to the press this afternoon.

I am not angry at you, I understand that you cannot rule against your Mormon masters. It would have been better if you had gotten off this case sooner. You should know that this ruling will most likely not survive appeal. I appreciate what you are trying to do, which is force a settlement, unfortunately, you have taken sides rather than show the backbone of taking your own side. This

has brought the Courts system in Utah into disrepute, and clearly demonstrates the political corruption that the Mormon Church injects into the local government and judiciary.

Perhaps one day, we will obtain justice, but clearly not in your Court. A rule 63B motion referencing incidents which occurred prior to this hearing will be cited as authorities to remove you. Please help us, Utah, and yourself by getting off this case.
