## MOTION OF PETROFSKY FOR AN ORDER DEEMING ELECTRONIC FILING APPROPRIATE

I, Alan P. Petrofsky, an equity security holder of Debtor The SCO Group, Inc., hereby move the court for an order deeming my participation in the Electronic Case Filing System ("ECF") appropriate.

#### JURISDICTION

1. In the Court's local procedures, which it established pursuant to its inherent authority under Article III of the Constitution, it reserved for itself the authority to determine the appropriateness of non-attorney ECF registrations "on a case by case basis" (Administrative Procedures For Electronically Filed Cases, section II(B)(3)). My request that the Court make this determination is being made by motion per LR 9013-1(b).

#### BACKGROUND

2. The Court's rules and procedures permit all attorneys to register for electronic filing, and they permit additional people to register as the Court deems appropriate, on a case by case basis. See LR 5005-4:

Attorneys who intend to practice in this Court (including those regularly admitted or admitted pro hac vice to the bar of the Court and attorneys authorized to represent the United States without being admitted to the bar) should register as CM/ECF users. United States Trustees, private trustees and others as the Court deems appropriate should also register as CM/ECF users. Registration forms, requirements and procedural information for CM/ECF are available on the Court's website.

(LR 5005-4)

and in the ECF procedures:

Each attorney admitted to practice in this Court and in good standing shall be entitled to an ECF System password to permit the attorney to participate in the electronic retrieval and filing of pleadings and other documents in accordance with the ECF System. Additional passwords may be issued, on a case by case basis, as deemed appropriate by the Court.

(Administrative Procedures For Electronically Filed Cases, section I(B).)

#### GROUNDS FOR RELIEF

- 3. Deeming electronic filing appropriate would result in cost savings to the court, to the other parties, and to me.<sup>1</sup> Specifically:
  - (a) The court would save the costs of scanning any papers I file.

 $<sup>^{1}</sup>$ My costs would possibly ultimately be borne by the estate, rather than by me, per 11 U.S.C. 503(b)(3)(D), but either way, electronic filing would save *somebody* some money, and innocent trees would be spared.

- (b) The other parties, including every party that ever needs to send a notice to the LR 2002-1(c) service list, would save the costs of sending paper copies of documents to me.
- (c) I would save the costs of printing and delivering my papers to the court and to the other parties.
- 4. The latter two savings would result from the fact that paper documents generally need not be served between parties that are both registered ECF users:

A party filing electronically is not required to serve the pleading or other document (other than the "Notice of Electronic Filing" generated by the ECF System) on any party who is a registered Electronic Case Filing participant and has been issued a live ECF System password. Upon filing of any pleading, the ECF System will send a Notice of Electronic Filing to all registered ECF participants and the confirmation received by the filing party will contain a list of all parties receiving such notice.

(Administrative Procedures For Electronically Filed Cases, section II(B)(3))

The undersigned attorney/participant consents to accept e-mail service in lieu of service of a paper copy of the document whenever service on the attorney is required of documents filed in cases on the Electronic Filing System as set forth in the most recent Interim Operating Order, Administrative Procedures and User Manual.

#### NOTICE

5. Notice of this Motion has been or will be given to the following parties: (i) the Debtors; (ii) the Office of the United States Trustee; (iii) the creditors holding the 20 largest unsecured claims against the Debtors' estates (on a consolidated basis); and (iv) every party that has filed a request for notices with the Court prior to the date of this Motion.

WHEREFORE, I respectfully request that the Court enter an order, substantially in the form attached hereto, granting (i) this Motion, and (ii) such other and further relief as this Court deems proper and just.


