**[Donald J Kundinger]**, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am a **President** of **Jackson Hole Advisors** (the "**Firm**"), which maintains offices at 700 Private Treaty Lane, Grover, Wyoming 83122
2. This Affidavit is submitted in connection with an Order of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, entered on or about November 6, 2007, authorizing the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "**Debtors**") to employ and compensate certain professionals in the ordinary course of business during the pendency of these chapter 11 cases.

3. Prior to the filing of the petitions which initiated the above-captioned cases, the Firm has represented and advised the Debtors as Firm has represented and advised the Debtors as Market Management-Market intelligence consultants. The Debtors have requested, and the Firm has agreed, to continue to provide such services to the Debtors on a post-petition basis during the course of these chapter 11 cases.

4. The Firm's current customary rates, subject to change from time to time, are [twenty six hundred fifty dollars (\$2650.00)]. In the normal course of its business, the Firm revises its billing rates on [NONE] of each year and requests that, effective [NONE] of each year, the aforementioned rates be revised to the regular hourly rates which will be in effect at that time.

5. In the ordinary course of its business, the Firm maintains a database for purposes of performing "conflicts checks." The Firm's database contains information regarding the firm's present and past representations. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2014(a), I obtained a list of the entities identified in Rule 2014(a) from counsel to the Debtors for purposes of searching the aforementioned database and determining the connection(s) which the Firm has with such entities. The Firm's search of the database identified the following connections:

7. Neither I nor any principal, partner, director, officer, etc. of, or professional employed by, the Firm, insofar as I have been able to ascertain, holds, or represents any interest adverse to the Debtors or their estates with respect to the matter(s) upon which the Firm is to be employed.


