ORDER ENFORCING ELECTRONIC TEXT REQUIREMENT

Based upon the Motion of Petrofsky for an Order Enforcing Electronic Text Requirement, good cause appearing therefore, and Local Rule 5005-4, which states, “All petitions, complaints, motions, briefs and other pleadings and documents to be filed electronically with the Court shall be converted to PDF, electronically, as opposed to scanning a document, where practicable”, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.

2. Henceforth, for the purposes of LR 5005-4, it will be presumed that the inclusion of accurate electronic text is practicable for all documents in the following categories (the “Presumed Practicable” documents): petitions, complaints, motions, briefs, notices, applications, objections, proposed orders, plans, disclosure

statements, schedules, periodic operating reports, declarations, and affidavits. The Presumed Practicable document types do not include exhibits nor certificates of service.

3. Henceforth, whenever any party in this case electronically files a Presumed Practicable document, the party shall either:

- (a) Ensure that the electronic document includes, in compliance with LR 5005-4, the accurate original electronic text, and not just an approximation generated from a scanned image; or
- (b) Include a certification describing the extraordinary circumstances that made the inclusion of accurate electronic text impracticable.

4. Within ten (10) days of the date that this order is entered on the docket, the Debtors shall file, for each of the following previously filed documents, a copy of the document that includes accurate electronic text:

- ~~{(a) The plan and disclosure statement (dkt. #654 and #655) filed on January 6, 2009}~~;
- (~~{b}~~)[a] The monthly operating reports (dkt. #646 and #647) filed on December 29, 2008; and
- (~~{e}~~)[b] Any subsequently filed monthly operating reports.
